- 2. Student Senate Bill #19-8: Work Room Furniture was discussed. The Senate Bill will be revisited in the next meeting.
 - a) Senator Mohammed discussed the dimensions of the furniture.
- 3. Student Senate Bill #20-56: Door locks were discussed and will be revisited in the next meeting.
- 4. Student Senate Bill #19-5: Table Runner was discussed and will be revisited in the next meeting.
- 5. Student Senate Bill #2020-3: Display Window Case was discussed. This case was not purchased and the Senate Bill has not been sent to fiscal. There was a discussion of the Senate bill regarding on-campus accessibility.
 - a) Senator Westbrook moved to approve the Student Bill #2020-3: Display Window Case. The motion was seconded by Senator Sharififard. Senator Allen, Senator Rodriguez, Senator Simonova, Senator Soliman, Senator Gard, Senator Sharififard, Senator Flores, Senator Westbrook, and Senator Maciel all voted in favor of the Senate Bill.
