 - b) November 30th, both documents will get placed for approval. Ratification will get done in the following meeting.
 - c) Bylaws Change: In the event the Legislative Advocate can not attend General Assembly, the ASSC President will represent the ASSC as the main delegate and must be verified to vote. In the event the Legislative Advocate can not make the Delegate Assembly, the ASSC President or appointed senator will represent the ASSC as an alternate and must be verified to vote.

 - e) Election Code Change: Addition of virtual election article that covers the circumstances for having a virtual election. Specifications can be made, such as the threshold of holding a virtual election.
