ADVANCED PLACEMENT

PROCEDURES:

The College shall award General Education Area credit per the California Community College General Education Advanced Placement (CCC GE AP) List.

Students who present scores of 3 (three) or better (subject matter) on the Advanced Placement (AP) Examinations may earn up to 6 (six) units of college credit and meet applicable General Education (GE) Area Requirements.

The awarding of course-to-course AP credit is determined locally by appropriate discipline faculty, and discipline faculty may set higher scores for acceptance of specific examinations.

Where a specific AP Exam listed on the CCC GE AP List is not included in the College's list of approved courses, and where the College does offer a similar course, the College shall award AP credit and units according to the California State University (CSU) baseline standard of a score of 3 (three), while acknowledging that each campus in the CSU determines locally how it will apply external examinations toward credit in its majors.

Where the College does not have a course similar in content to an AP exam, the College shall award credit for the indicated GE area as identified on the CCC GE AP List.

Where there is no GE Area that aligns with the subject of an AP Examination, the College may award elective credit.

Credit shall be applied to General Education requirements of the General Education, Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC), or California State University General Education (CSUGE) options.

These procedures shall be listed in the Solano Community College Catalog and posted on the Solano Community College website.
