Board President Martin turned the meeting over to Superintendent-President Celia Esposito-Noy who presented an update on the budget and structural deficit. Trustees discussed the status of the Vacaville and Vallejo Centers and the surrounding properties.

Understanding Leadership Roles

Facilitated by Frances L. White, Ph.D., Community College Search Services

Dr. White facilitated a general discussion the Trustees on understanding leadership roles which included an overview of building a leadership team and characteristics of winning board teams. Trustees participated in short scenarios and discussions of outcomes.

Dr. White spoke in depth on two subjects: CEO Expectations for Trustees, and Trustees Expectations for CEOs. Both topics provided the Trustees and Superintendent-President a better understanding of effective roles and responsibilities.

Trustee Young asked about long-term planning, specifically a 5-year plan. Dr. White stated that a good way to begin is to update the Education Master Plan, which provides a solid foundation for making good Board decisions and gives options. Dr. White reminded the Trustees that Board members only have authority when operating as a group.

11. ANNOUNCEMENTS

Trustee Brown announced that there is a \$9 million schoolwide facility bond which will be on the November 2016 ballot. An information sheet detailing the bond was distributed to the Trustees for review, and consideration to adopt a resolution for Solano Community College District.

There being no further business to come before the Board, it was moved by Trustee Young and seconded by Trustee Thurston to adjourn the meeting at 1:10 p.m.
