(a) Budget & Enrollment Update

Vice President Yulian Ligioso gave an update on the budget and a comprehensive enrollment management overview. VP Ligioso discussed reserve guidelines and reducing reliance on stability. The long-range budget outlook included discussion on growth, pension, and employee health and welfare. Enrollment statistics for fiscal year 2015-16 were presented, focusing on FTEs.

(b) 2017 Board Goals

The Board identified the following priorities for 2017-2018:

- Monitor the status and activities related to Measure Q
- Ensure the College has appropriately met accreditation requirements
- Be more involved in legislative advocacy

The Board identified the following Superintendent-President goals for 2017-2018:

<u>Student Enrollment</u>. Increase student enrollment by a strong community outreach program to local schools and communities to attract a more diverse student group and implement a comprehensive management enrollment plan. Work with Vallejo Unified School District and

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Benicia Unified School District to explore establishing a Middle/Early College at the Vallejo Center.

<u>Student Success</u>. Ensure student success and student equity plans are continually implemented and outcomes are assessed.

Accreditation. Ensure that the college maintains accreditation without sanctions

Funding and structural deficit. Explore new sources of funding for the college.

<u>Bond.</u> Continue to make sure projects remain on schedule and within budget. Keep updates on website for the public.

<u>Education and Facilities Master Plans</u>. Review and update facilities master plan to also include a comprehensive plan on present and future use of all properties. Review and update educational master plan to ensure all programs will meet job skills needed for the future.

(c) Board Requested Information Items

The Board discussed various information only topics which included graduation planning, professional development and future activities.

Trustee Young invited the trustees to Juneteenth this weekend in Vallejo. Trustee Young will be in attendance and Solano College will have a table at the event.
