The Board is asked to approve a contract to Clawson Automotive Equipment and Service, Inc. in the amount of \$15,300.00 for installation services; and Snap-On Industrial in the amount of \$65,893.50 for the purchase of owner-furnished storage and shelving units.

This project is being fully funded using a generous donation made by the Syar Foundation, which was founded in 1998 by C.M "Tony" Syar and his wife B.M. "Boots" Syar as a not-for-profit corporation to support the communities where Syar Industries, Inc. operated and grew into the company it is today. Since 2006, the Syar Foundation has made over \$4.5 million in grants, including a grant to support the the District's Automotive Technology Program after the completion of the new Auto Technology facility in Vallejo.

Program:

 <u>Facilities Master Plan</u> – The District continues its update to the currently adopted Facilities Master Plan.

Campus Projects:

- <u>Library/Learning Resource Center:</u> Construction continues. Work on the building pad proceeded and was certified. Interior footings work, columns and elevator work have begun. Utilities and phase 2 of slab on grade are underway. Furniture and equipment for early spring 2020 purchase ordered and partially delivered and stored.
- <u>B300 Modifications Graphics & Mailroom</u> Construction has started and is proceeding. Move coordination is underway.
- <u>B1800B Exterior Roof Canopy</u> This project consists of replacing a failing existing roof structure serving an outdoor lab space for students learning to use welding equipment and various pieces of machinery. The scope of work includes design, construction and installation, as well as DSA coordination and close out.
- <u>Bleacher Replacement Baseball and Soccer</u> Construction has started and is moving along well. Bleachers are on site and installation is to be complete in July. Design for Baseball access ramp is in process.
- <u>Parking Lot #1 Resurfacing</u> Construction started and has been completed. DSA approval is proceeding.
- <u>Early College High School Portables</u> This project consists of the addition of two (2) portable classrooms on the Fairfield Campus. These classrooms will be utilized by the Early College High School Program during the upcoming school year. The project will include design, DSA submittal and construction. Design for site work complete and bidding is proceeding. Portables have been ordered and are in production.
- <u>Early Learning Center Modernization (Design)</u> Initial study and schematic design is proceeding.
- <u>Building 800 Parking Lot (Lot A2) Rehabilitation</u> and <u>Fairfield Campus Perimeter Road Striping</u> Completed and Closed.
- <u>Fairfield Campus Building Exteriors (Design)</u> Design is in process and assessing priority work and scoping for next phase of the project.
