REVISED ASSESSMENT SCHEDULE

The assessment schedule was revised to accommodate the transition to META. PLO assessments are being delayed to focus on inputting SLO assessments in META. SLO assessments are the foundation of PLO assessments, so they must be inputted first. See the revised schedule below, passed by Academic Senate on 11/13/17.

IMPORTANT DUE DATES:

Friday December 22, 2017 – The last day to input SLO only changes in CurricUNET META to be eligible for the contest. All schools that have all their SLOs updated in META by this date will get their spring flex meeting catered! If no school is complete, the school with the highest percentage of completions will win. There are many schools that have made significant progress toward this goal, please support the college and your colleagues by getting these done.

Friday January 19, 2018 – The “SLO Only” button will be removed from CurricUNET META. After this date, to update SLOs, faculty will need to submit a course modification which will have to go through the full curriculum committee process. This is because SLOs, like course objectives, or methods of instruction, etc. are part of the official course outline of record. It is not until the course has gone through the full curriculum process and has received board approval, that the SLO changes will be made “live” and thus be assessable. Thus, to ready all SLOs for assessment, it is highly advantageous that they are updated before this date.
